1. COURSE DESCRIPTION

Content for learning and training can range from simple use of text-only pages to sophisticated use of multimedia elements including audio, video, animation and simulation. In the past, development tools for learning content were costly, difficult to learn and master. In today's context, the tools are generally user-friendly, template-driven and low cost. Anyone can tap into a range of free Open Source and limited licenses that offer a rich set of tools to develop rich media learning resources. This hands-on workshop will walk you through a common set free Open Source tools and cloud-based limited license tools to develop rich media learning resources.

No programming of computer languages is required. All you need is a good working experience of Microsoft Office tools (Word and PowerPoint).

- b. Record and edit audio recordings
